

## Event Date: June 16, 2018

### General

- **Q:** What items are accepted for drop-off?
- *A:* The Nipomo Clean Up event will be limited to furniture, scrap metals, mattresses, appliances, and junk vehicles. NO general trash, rubbish, green-waste, or hazardous waste will be collected during the event.
- **Q:** What if I am not able to bring my items to the event site?
- *A*: Off-site pick up may be available in your area. Please contact the administrative staff or code enforcement investigators prior to June 12th to schedule a pick-up. Availability on pick-up is limited and subject to address proximity to event site and amount of items requested to be picked up.

### **Vehicle Abatement**

- **Q:** What do I need to drop-off an unwanted junk vehicle?
- *A*: A completed registration form is required prior to event abatement. Vehicle Registration Event Forms are available online to print and mail-in or bring to the event site along with the vehicle. For more information please contact Administrative staff or a Code Enforcement Investigator.
- **Q:** What is considered a junk vehicle?
- *A*: A junked vehicle is one which has been dismantled because it was wrecked, abandoned, or a low valued vehicle that was impounded and acquired from an enforcement agency and is no longer operable.
- **Q:** What if I don't have the title to my junk vehicle?
- *A*: A vehicle event registration form will need to be submitted and DMV clearance will be required for all vehicles without title. Contact a local DMV agency to obtain title information on your vehicle ahead of time. A law enforcement agent will be available on-site during the event to help facilitate DMV clearance and required abatement forms.

# *ALL* junk vehicles towed to the event site must be towed lawfully and in compliance with California Vehicle Code.

#### **NOT ACCEPTED during event**

- **Q:** Can I bring hazardous waste to the event for disposal?
- *A*: NO Hazardous Materials will be collected during the Nipomo Community Clean Up event. Please contact the local landfill and sanitization facilities for hazardous waste disposal and recycling.
- **Q:** Will green waste and landscape materials be accepted during the event?

# Nipomo Community Clean Up—FAQs

- *A:* NO Green Waste will be collected during the Nipomo Community Clean Up event. Please contact local landfill and sanitation facilities for green-waste collection and recycling.
- *Q*: Can I bring household and general trash items to the event?
- *A:* NO general rubbish or debris will be collected during the event. The Nipomo Clean Up event will be limited to furniture, scrap metals, mattresses, app
