

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

Who: County of San Luis Obispo

What: A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and issued for the El

Camino Real Bridge Replacement Project, located in the community of Santa Margarita. The San Luis Obispo County Public Works Department proposes to replace the existing bridge on El Camino Real over Santa Margarita Creek with a new cast in place, concrete slab bridge on an improved alignment. The purpose of the project is to improve public safety along this portion of the roadway because the existing bridge is deteriorating and hydraulically inadequate. Implementation of the project will improve the roadway alignment with incorporation of a consistent 55-mile per hour posted speed corridor and a center turn lane. The project site is in the North County planning area, Salinas River subarea, within

Supervisorial District 5.
