#### 4. Core Practices

  - ii. Experienced the longest amount of time homeless
  - iii. Multiple and severe service needs
  - iv. People who are at greatest risk of becoming literally homeless without an intervention
- b. Housing First, Low Barrier
  - i. Low barrier easily accessible assistance to all people (including personw tih active substance abuse or mental health issues)
