## **Title 19 Retrofit-to-Build Fixtures Credits**

Use the table below to calculate the number of credits that can be obtained from fixture replacements. Identify the existing fixture flow rate (either gallons per flush or gallons per minute), then identify the corresponding replacement flow rate. The number of credits that can be obtained vary by building type: single-family residential, multi-family residential, and mobile home.

For example, a developer who replaces a 3.5 GPF toilet with a 1.1 GPF toilet in a mobile home would obtain 13 credits. When more than one fixture of the same type (toilet or showerhead) is replaced in the same home, the number of credits obtained is an average of the number of credits for that fixture type. For example, a developer who replaces one 5 GPM showerhead with a 1.5 showerhead and one 2.5 GPM showerhead with a 1.5 GPM Showerhead in the same single-family home would obtain 10 credits ((13 + 7) / 2).
