- A) **Probation / Juvenile Hall / Coastal Valley Academy** – (Jim Salio) The numbers at Juvenile Hall are staying low. Reported record low numbers for the month of August.

- B) **DSS / CWS** – (Elise Roberts) No report
- C) **DA’s Office** – (James Graff-Radford) Reported no reports came from the fair this year. Reported 33% percent uptake in referrals compared from last year.
- D) **County Counsel** – (no comments)
- E) **SLOCOE** – (Karen Donaghe & Katherine Aaron) School begins August 20th. The reduction of children in the hall impacted the classroom sizes with SLOCOE. SLOCOE currently has two classrooms, one being CVA and a custody

COMMITTEE / COMMISSIONER REPORT

- A) **Legislation** – (Jim Salio) SB439 This bill would modify the ages that a person must be to fall within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court or adjudged a ward of the court under these circumstances to between 12 years of age and 17 years of age, inclusive, except that any minor who is under 12 years of age when he or she is alleged to have committed murder or rape, sodomy, oral copulation, or sexual penetration by force, violence, or threat of great bodily harm would still be within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court and may be adjudged a ward of the court. The bill was amended; currently the amendments include rape, sodomy, oral copulation, or sexual penetration by force. CPOC is opposing this bill.

SB391- Changes the age from 14 to 16 that a Juvenile can be transferred to the Adult court for a 707b offense. CPOC has a neutral opposition on this bill.

AB 1214 This set the time limits for Juvenile Competency Restoration in the Juvenile Court. This would set a one-year time frame for a felony.

- B) **Children's Services Network** – (Kayla Plourde) A conference is in the works for the month of November.
- C) **Truancy Board Meeting** – (Amalia Plemons) Next meeting will take place sometime in November.
