- E) **SLOCOE** – (Karen Donaghe & Katherine Aaron) The Career Technical Education Teacher position has been filled by an inhouse staff member. The fall summit will be at the Cuesta Campus on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 from 4:30 to 7:15 pm. The key note speaker is from Rachel's Challenge. Rachel was the first student killed in a Columbine shooting.
- F) **Law Enforcement** – (Aaron Nix) Reported on the Active Shooter update mapping process. The goal is to have all law enforcement agencies respond from the same map as well as the same key codes; efforts are being made to have a cookie cutter model for all departments.

COMMITTEE / COMMISSIONER REPORT

- I) **Legislation** – (Jim Salio) The Legislative session is over for this year. Governor Brown has signed three huge bills for Juvenile Justice.
- AB 1214 This sets the time limits for Juvenile Competency Restoration in the Juvenile Court. This would set a one-year time frame for the restoration of competency in Juvenile Hall.
 - SB439 This bill would modify the ages that a person must be to fall within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court or adjudged a ward of the court under these circumstances to between 12 years of age and 17 years of age, inclusive, except that any minor who is under 12 years of age when he or she is alleged to have committed murder or rape, sodomy, oral copulation, or sexual penetration by force, violence, or threat of great bodily harm would still be within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court and may be adjudged a ward of the court. The bill was amended; currently the

amendments include rape, sodomy, oral copulation, or sexual penetration by force.

- SB1391- Changes the age from 14 to 16 that a Juvenile can be transferred to the Adult court for a 707b offense.
