Dale –regarding Dale Sutliff's email to Committee- Continued concern for omitting shoulder/bike lane paving during re-paved street projects. BAC was informed that bike paving would no longer be separated but combined. -

Skip – Elaborating on Dale’s comment – County is repairing iffy surfaces, but not addressing shoulders.

Josh Roberts – Pavement management projects, BOS approved, via public contract. County policy is to re-surface the entire travel way, including the bike lanes. However, often, roadway requires corrective patching, due to loading damage from travel lanes. Surface damage and structural damage is not the same.

Public Comment – Committee prioritizes areas they’d like to see improved..

Josh Roberts – Help by keeping the calls coming regarding issues to bike lanes and shoulders. Board adopted some new policies recognizing funding is never going to reach the needed goals, taking a “worst first” approach.

Jim - Public Comment – Resurfacing roads

Josh Roberts – State of good repair.

Jim – Condition of roads

Deborah – Responding to Jim’s comment regarding conditions of road.

Skip – Grant seeking status – Shoulders, road widening comments
