

Warming Center Transportation

Paso Warming Center: There is transportation from the Warming Center back to the 2nd Baptist Church in the morning, but no additional transportation is provided by the Warming Center. There are several public transit (the Paso Express bus) pick up locations along Riverside Avenue within a few blocks from the church. See the links above for timetables, stops, and fares.

South County Warming Center: When the Center is scheduled to open there is limited transportation provided to and from:
