

## Adult Protective Services Multidisciplinary Team (APS MDT) Meeting

- Replaces the Inter-Agency Meeting -

**WHAT IS THE PURPOSE?** The APS MDT Meeting is used to collaborate with Community Partners to determine what resources are available and appropriate to help with health and safety for vulnerable seniors and dependent adults.

**WHO CAN ATTEND?** This is an opportunity for community partner agencies, who are identified as MDT members and whose expertise may benefit the meeting, to meet and discuss what resources are available to assist a client.

**WHEN ARE THE MEETINGS HELD?** The meetings are held as necessary. All members of the APS MDT have the opportunity to request an MDT meeting.

WHERE IS THE LOCATION OF THE MEETING? The meetings are held virtually. If an in-person meeting is necessary, it is held at:

## HOW do I request an APS MDT meeting?

- 1. The agency requesting an MDT meeting is responsible for contacting APS. APS is responsible for coordinating and facilitating the MDT meeting.

  - The agency requesting the meeting will provide the name of the client and the reason for needing an MDT meeting.
- 2. Prior to each MDT meeting, APS will confirm a current and signed APS MDT Confidentiality Agreement is on file for each member attending the meeting.
  - Prior to the meeting, APS will coordinate with any member who does not have a current Confidentiality Agreement signed and on file. Note: Confidentiality Agreements are good for 12 months from the signing date.
- 3. APS will email an MDT meeting invitation prior to meeting.
- 4. A telephone call will be made to all agencies attending MDT meeting to disclose name of the client to be discussed during the meeting.
