Student Exemptions

- ◆ Be employed for a minimum of twenty hours per week and be paid for such employment.
- ◆ Be approved for state or federally financed work study for the current school term. If you are approved for work study and do not find a job, you will not be penalized.
- ◆ Have parental control over a dependent household member under the age of 6.
- ◆ Have parental control over a dependent household member who is 6 but under 12 and determined to not have adequate child care available.
- ◆ Be a recipient of CalWORKs.
- ◆ Be a single parent enrolled full-time with a dependent under 12.
- ◆ Be enrolled in EOPS or WIOA activity.
- ◆ Be participating in the Disabled Students Program & Services (DSPS).
- ◆ Be participating in the Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education (CARE) Program.
- ◆ Be participating in the UC McNair Program.
- ◆ Be participating in the Puente Project Program.
- ◆ Be participating in the Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement (MESA) Program.
- ◆ Be participating in the Guardian Scholars Program.
- ◆ Be participating in the Foster Youth Success Initiative (FYSI).
- ◆ Be participating in the Cooperating Agencies Foster Youth Educational Support (CAFYES) Program.
- ◆ Be participating in the Chafee Education and Training Voucher Program.
- ◆ Receive Extender Foster Care (AB 12/AB 212)
- ◆ Receive a Cal Grant A or B and are unmarried, 25 years old or under and income used in approving the grant is \$50,000 a year or less.
