This grant also allows more time to spend the funding than the HEAP grant. Laurel explained to the group that there will be a discussion at the Full HSOC meeting about rescheduling the next meeting to December due to the grant deadlines.</p> <p>Laurel informed the group that there is an application due to Housing and Urban Development at the end of the month. The Board signed off on the rankings for the application. There will be a discussion at the Full HSOC meeting regarding a partnership with the workforce development board in support of this application.</p> <p>There has been a request submitted to HUD for technical assistance for our Homeless Management Information System. The group assisting with the changes has already made a suggestions and will have more soon. There will be more suggestions from this group that will be brought back to the Finance and Data Committee. One of the recommendations will be to split off the Finance function and focus strictly on Data.</p> <p>Laurel shared with the group information about other federal grants including HASLO's application for the mainstream vouchers using our HMIS data to apply for the 100 vouchers. The vouchers would be targeting those that are at risk of homelessness or currently experiencing homelessness. If successful, HASLO will receive</p>		
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	the vouchers in the fall. Another federal grant that was not to be: there was a notice of funding availability due next month focusing on victims of human trafficking. HUD has cancelled this funding.
