4.1 Discussion Item: Racial Disparities Analysis	Laurel explained that the racial disparities analysis report come from our 2017 Point in Time Count surveys. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has asked that we look at the number of people in poverty based on race and ethnicity. Laurel shared the report with the group. The purpose of this report is to look at systemic bias. Please see the attached graph for information. Additional data from the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) will be compared to this and shared with the group at a future meeting. The group discussed looking at the demographic of the Point in Time count surveys.

The group discussed combining the funding into one to help with efficiency. Laurel asked groups to send warming center data attendance including children 15-24 as well as overall night attendance of shelters soon. Additional guidance will be shared soon.
