The program provides assessments, individual therapy and group counseling, including medication services. Reduction of services may result in longer wait times. Home Visiting Program/Maternal Child and Adolescent Health (MCAH) Countywide	Reduction of home visiting programs and health coordination, which provide home and community-based services to high-risk pregnant and parenting families. Medically Indigent Services 2180 Johnson Avenue San Luis Obispo, 93401	Reduction of administrative services including healthcare navigation, MISP enrollment, utilization review, and payment referrals. Elimination of helping county residents answer general healthcare system questions and check Medi-Cal and Covered California status.
