Argument in Favor of Measure B-26

Vote YES on Measure B-26 to create Sunnyside Park — a lasting public benefit for all of Los Osos.

Los Osos has a severe shortage of community park space, with only one small park serving the entire town. This leaves children with limited safe places to play, families with few options for active recreation, seniors without adequate venues for physical activity and social engagement, and community groups struggling to find space for youth sports.

The 12-acre Sunnyside School property, located beside the existing park, represents a unique opportunity to change that. Sunnyside would become Sunnyside Park, providing fields, playgrounds, and open space for everyone in the heart of Los Osos. Its office buildings could house community services, while classrooms could be leased to generate revenue and help offset costs. Turning Sunnyside into a park and center for community services would boost active recreational opportunities, promote health and emotional well-being, and enhance community connections.

For too long, Los Osos has lacked the community parks every town deserves, and this need has been overlooked for decades, but Measure B-26 finally offers a solid path forward. The path is grounded not only in extensive community input gathered through meetings, town halls, and surveys, but also by a rigorous financial analysis. All funds will stay in Los Osos and be used exclusively to acquire, operate, and maintain Sunnyside Park under the Los Osos Community Services District. Future improvements will be funded by grants and donations.





