

Rebuttal to Argument Against Measure G-26

Measure G-26 invests in our children's future with real taxpayer protections.

Opponents cry "mismanagement," yet cannot name a single misspent dollar. That's because claims that the district's bond spending has gone unchecked are simply untrue.

In 2016, this community trusted the district to modernize our elementary schools—and it delivered. Every dollar spent was independently audited and fully disclosed as **required by State law**.

Members of the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee—neighbors like you—have donated their time to review how bond funds are spent. Although filling committee vacancies has been challenging, the District has continually sought new members. (Proof that it's easier to criticize than to serve—**not one of the five signers** of the opposing argument has **ever** volunteered to be on this committee.)

Measure G-26 will improve aging and deteriorating classrooms at our local high schools. It will modernize Career Technical Education Centers that prepare students for well-paying skilled trades, college, and local careers, while repairing leaky roofs, deteriorating plumbing, failing electrical systems, and inefficient heating and cooling systems.

- Every dollar stays in Paso Robles and cannot be taken by the State and spent elsewhere. It's the law.
- Independent annual audits and full public disclosure of all spending are mandatory.
- Not one cent for administrator salaries, pensions, or benefits.
