- Spearhead at least 2 voter outreach events of your own during the 2025-26 school year – on-campus, in the community, via social media, etc. – and report back to the Elections Office about how they went (with photos and/or screenshots)
- Encourage future students' participation in the program

Support you'll get



- Training in voter registration requirements and best practices
- Access to Elections Center materials (tablecloth, pop-up tent, etc.) as needed
- An outreach kit with Elections Office credentials, t-shirt, voter registration materials, & tally sheets
- An advisor to help you with questions and troubleshooting throughout the school year
- Zoom check-in/brainstorming meetings with all participants (once in fall and once in spring)

How to get started



- Submit the <u>application</u>, get accepted, and get assigned an advisor
- Complete the self-paced online training course
- Attend a kickoff meeting in person at the SLO County Elections Center in August
