The Clerk-Recorder and the people who work for her keep track of a lot of important things for the people who live here!



We keep all sorts of important documents, like marriage and death certificates, and we have records that can tell you who owns property in San Luis Obispo County.




Why is the Clerk-Recorder's Office important to county residents? Why might it be important to people who don't live here?

We also run local, state, and national elections.


When people vote in San Luis Obispo County, they get a special sticker that says "I Voted."

Arguments for the measure


(reasons to consider voting yes):

MEASURE B

Arguments for the measure


(reasons to consider voting yes):

- -More opportunities to recharge

Arguments against the measure

(reasons to consider voting no):

- -No long break to recharge
- -Harder to schedule family time
- -Few opportunities that come with traditional summer breaks



San Luis Obispo County's **FIVE DISTRICTS**



The Board of Supervisors is a group of 5 people who help take care of our county. Each Supervisor represents a different part of the county, and these parts are called districts.

The Supervisors work together to make good decisions about things like fixing roads, building parks, helping firefighters and police, and making sure people have what they need.

Here are the districts and the Supervisors who represent them. Which one repesents your city or town?

District 1: John Peschong represents Paso Robles, Atascadero, San Miguel, Shandon, Bradley, Heritage Ranch, Nacimiento, Cholame, Whitley Gardens.

District 2: Bruce Gibson represents Morro Bay, Cambria, Cayucos, Los Osos, San Simeon, Harmony.

District 3: Dawn Ortiz-Legg represents Pismo Beach, Grover Beach, parts of San Luis Obispo (southern and southeastern parts), Avila Beach, Avila Valley, Shell Beach, Edna Valley, Oak Park.

District 4: Jimmy Paulding represents Arroyo Grande, Grover Beach (southern part), Nipomo, Oceano, Halcyon, Huasna Valley.

District 5: Heather Moreno represents San Luis Obispo (northern and central parts), Atascadero, Santa Margarita, Creston, Pozo, Garden Farms.
