ADOPTION OF FIRE HAZARD SEVERITY ZONES IN THE LRA

Pursuant to the California Government Code and California Fire Code, the San Luis Obispo County Fire Department hereby notifies the public of the adoption of Fire Hazard Severity Zones (FHSZs) within the Local Responsibility Area (LRA) of unincorporated San Luis Obispo County. This adoption aligns with applicable laws and regulations aimed at enhancing wildfire prevention and safety.

Purpose:

The adoption of these Fire Hazard Severity Zones aims to identify and assess areas of potential wildfire hazard, facilitating the implementation of appropriate fire safety measures. This initiative is part of ongoing efforts to protect life, property, and natural resources from the dangers posed by wildfires.
