AGENCY-PROGRAM REPORTS	
Maya Craig-Lauer	 The CHEMPACK Training is scheduled for June 12th. We will be releasing additional information soon.
PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY	 The Medical Response and Surge Exercise will be held on April 24th.
Preparedness (PHEP)	 We are assisting OES with an upcoming EMAD Exercise this summer in June and July.
	 This year we are catching up on reviewing our plans and SOPs. In total, we are reviewing 16 plans and SOPs.
	 The first grant year of our new five-year cycle ends in June, and we are on track to wrap up this year's deliverables.
Kristin Edler Public Health Communicable	• The week 12 respiratory report shows the following positivity rates: 2.1% COVID, 4.8% Influenza, 3.1% RSV. All are continuing to decrease and are relatively low.
DISEASE NURSE	 Measles cases total 483 in the country with majority in Texas in individuals under 20 years old. 97% are unvaccinated or status is unknown.
DR. GLEN MILLER PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY	• The laboratory hosted a bioterrorism workshop for clinical laboratory scientists in March at Allen Hancock College. Participants came from commercial and hospital labs in Ventura, Santa Barbara, and SLO.

• Measles cases continue to rise in Texas and other states, including New Mexico and Kansas. The lab

remains prepared to test for measles, with a turnaround time of one day.

- Influenza surveillance has shown, to date, no detection of H5N1 avian influenza.
- The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services is terminating \$11 billion in COVID funding that had been used to support equipment upgrades, surveillance activities for drug-resistance bacteria, and personnel.

JESSIE BURMESTER PUBLIC HEALTH EPIDEMIOLOGIST

- Public Health is sending out a provider advisory on measles on 4/4. There has not been a case of measles since 2018.
- Wastewater surveillance is available on the respiratory diseases page on the county website.
- There was a spike in influenza and this year showed the lowest rate of individuals vaccinated since the 2017-2018 flu year.
- In 2024, there was reported the highest number of cases of valley fever. A lot of provider and public education is being released.
