1. Mitigated Negative Declaration

Toro Creek Road Bridge Replacement Project, ED19-255 (300557)

SCH Number: 2025030290

A Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared and issued for the County of San Luis Obispo Department of Public Works, Toro Creek Road at Toro Creek Bridge Replacement Project. The purpose of this project is to improve public safety by replacing the existing bridge, considered functionally obsolete, with a new bridge that will conform to current standards. In addition to serving residences along Toro Creek Road, the bridge also provides access for wildland firefighting. The proposed bridge replacement would consist of a single span, cast-in-place concrete slab structure measuring 60 feet long and 24 feet wide, with two 10-foot traffic lanes, and concrete barriers. Traffic will be accommodated during construction with a temporary detour bridge adjacent to the existing bridge. Construction activities would occur over a period of 6 months and are anticipated to begin in May 2027. Construction will be scheduled during the non-rainy season when conditions are dry, or creek flows are at their lowest, however creek diversion and dewatering may be required. Avoidance, minimization, and mitigation measures will be implemented to ensure project impacts are less than significant. The project is located within the Salinas River Subarea of the North County Planning Area, Supervisorial District 2, approximately 2 miles north of State Route 41 and west of Atascadero in a rural, unincorporated area of the county.
