### Proposed Negative Declarations

A Negative Declaration is issued for projects that would not result in significant effects on the environment. In many cases, the project applicant has added mitigation measures to the project to reduce environmental impacts in order to qualify for a Negative Declaration. If you disagree with the issuance of a proposed Negative Declaration, you may provide comments or file a Request for Review (appeal) of the Negative Declaration. Requests for Review must be filed within two weeks of the date that the proposed Negative Declaration is posted and must address only environmental issues. There is a fee for the request. #### **SUB2016-00010 [CO13-0006] VANDERHEYDEN PARCEL MAP (ED18-115)**

Request by Paul Vanderheyden and Lucia Cleveland for a Vesting Tentative Parcel Map) (CO 13-0006) to subdivide an existing 21.6-acre parcel into two parcels of 10.0 and 11.6 acres each for the purpose of sale and/or development. The project will result in the disturbance of up to 1.2 acres of the undeveloped parcel depending on the size and location of future development. The proposed project is within the Residential Rural land use category. The project is located approximately 500 feet east of the eastern terminus of Tiburon Way, on the east side of Orcutt Road, located on the eastern boundary of the City of San Luis Obispo, in the San Luis Obispo North Sub Area of the San Luis Obispo planning area.
