PURPOSE

This acknowledgement documents the applicant's understanding of, and agreement to comply with, all applicable fire and life safety requirements and program limitations for Type 93 Estate Tasting Events conducted pursuant to AB 720, San Luis Obispo County requirements, and the 2025 California Fire Code (CFC), as determined and enforced by the San Luis Obispo County Fire Marshal.

Applicants must read each item carefully, initial where indicated, and sign at the end. Compliance with this acknowledgement is a condition of permit approval.

SECTION A — Program Limitations & Operational Constraints

(Applicant must initial each item)

A1. _____ I will limit attendance to no more than 49 persons, including staff, for any single event.

A2. _____ I will not exceed 36 Type 93 events per calendar year for this permit.

A3. _____ I will ensure Average Daily Trips (ADT) generated by each event remain below 40, as represented in my application materials.

A4. _____ All events will be conducted during daylight hours only and each event will be limited to a single calendar day.

A5. _____ Events will occur outdoors only and not within any structure that requires a building permit, including tasting rooms, barns, enclosed structures, or habitable buildings. Temporary structures that require a building or operational permit under the CFC are not authorized unless separately reviewed and approved by the Fire Marshal.

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A6. _____ Events will be cancelled or postponed during Red Flag Warnings or other hazardous fire weather conditions, as determined by the National Weather Service, CAL FIRE, or the Fire Code Official.

A7. _____ I acknowledge that I am solely responsible for ensuring that all event activities adhere to all applicable federal, state, or local rules, regulations, codes, or ordinances, including but not limited to: building and fire safety, ADA accessibility, food safety, water, and public health requirements.

SECTION B — Access, Egress & Emergency Vehicle Requirements

(Applicant must initial each item)

B1. _____ I will maintain unobstructed emergency-vehicle access at all times, including a minimum 12-foot clear roadway width and 13 feet 6 inches minimum vertical clearance on all primary access route serving the event.

B2. _____ Required turnouts and turnarounds will be provided and maintained as shown on the approved site plan to allow safe ingress, egress, and emergency operations.

B3. _____ No parking will be permitted in emergency access lanes, on primary access roads, or in any location that obstructs emergency vehicle access, turnouts, or turnarounds.

SECTION C — Means of Egress & Crowd Safety

(Applicant must initial each item)

C1. _____ I will maintain clear and unobstructed means of egress from the event area at all times. Exit paths will remain free of trip hazards, vehicles, equipment, and storage, in accordance with the California Fire Code.

SECTION D — Fire Protection Equipment & Open Flames

(Applicant must initial each item)

D1. _____ I will provide portable fire extinguishers on site in locations and quantities approved by the Fire Code Official. Extinguishers will be accessible, visible, and properly mounted.

D2. _____ Open flames, including candles, bonfires, fire pits, barbeques, charcoal grills, pyrotechnics, or open-flame heating devices, are prohibited unless specifically approved in writing by the Fire Marshal and permitted as required by the California Fire Code.

D3. _____ Generators, fuel, and LP-gas equipment, if used, will be located, secured, and operated in compliance with the California Fire Code and as approved by the Fire Code Official. Equipment and fuel storage will not obstruct exits or emergency access.

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SECTION E — Notification, Incident Reporting, & Inspections

(Applicant must initial each item)

E1. _____ I will notify the San Luis Obispo County Fire Marshal's Office as soon as practicable if any of the following occur during an event: fire, explosion, medical emergency requiring first responders, blocked emergency access, or evacuation.

E2. _____ I grant permission for Fire Marshal inspections, as deemed necessary, before and during event operations and agree to immediately correct any hazardous conditions identified. Failure to comply may result in event termination and permit enforcement action.

SECTION F — Operational & Staffing Requirements

(Applicant must initial each item)

F1. _____ Event personnel will be informed of emergency procedures and evacuation routes, and a plan will be in place to assist individuals with disabilities during an emergency.

F2. _____ All alcohol service will comply with ABC regulations, and service practices will not create additional fire or life-safety hazards, including crowding near exits or emergency access routes.

SECTION G — Applicant Affirmation & Signature

I affirm, under penalty of perjury, that the information provided in this acknowledgement and all attached materials is true and correct. I understand that approval of a Type 93 permit by the San Luis Obispo County Fire Marshal is conditioned upon ongoing compliance with all requirements stated herein, the California Fire Code, San Luis Obispo County standards, and all other applicable laws and approvals. I further understand that failure to comply may result in modification, suspension, or revocation of the permit.
