Generates 18,000 GWh annually

- Approx. 9% of CA's energy
- Approx. 17% of CA clean energy
- Powers four million people

Current NRC operating licenses expire

- Unit 1: November 2044
- Unit 2: August 2045

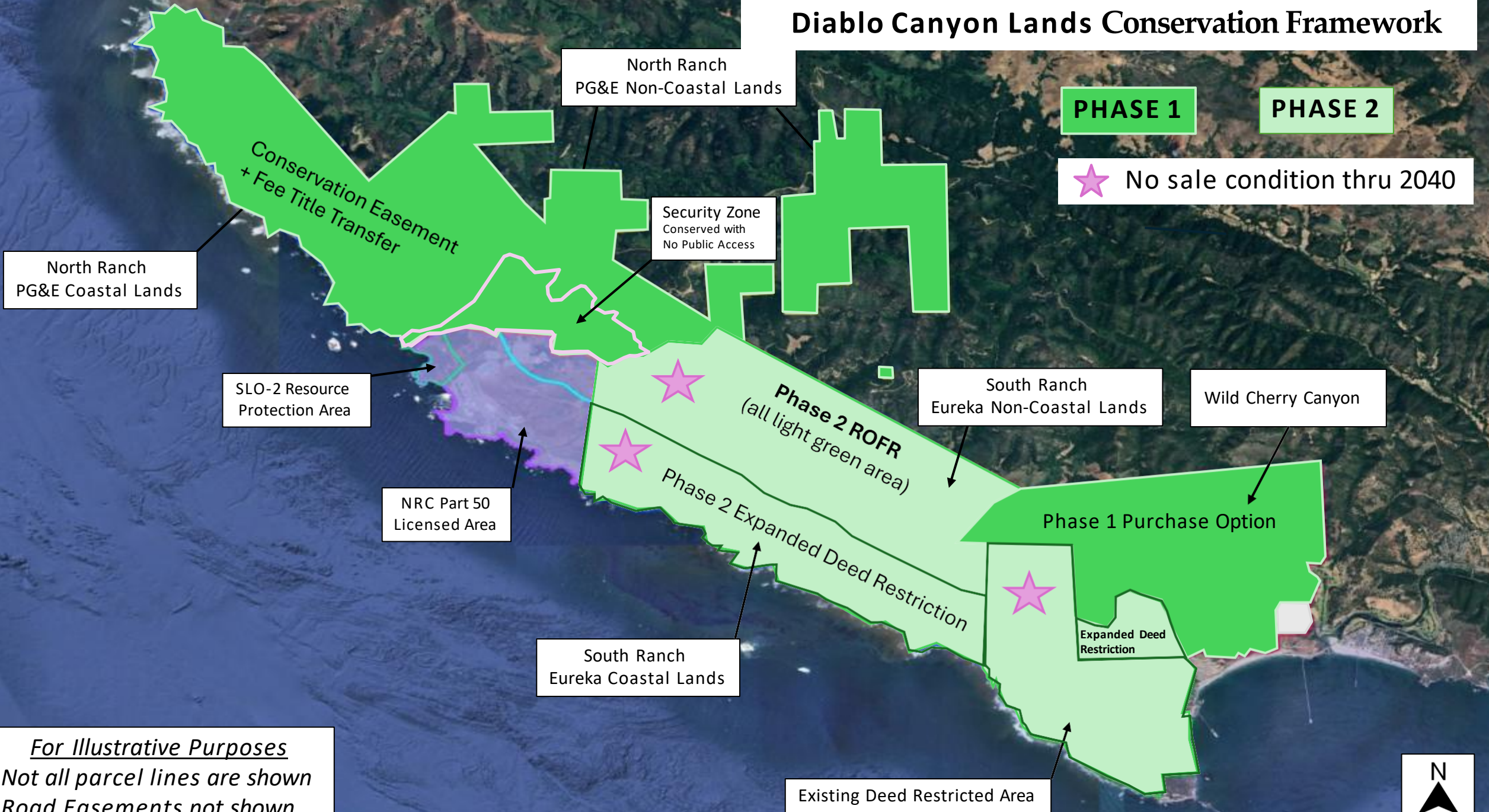


Diablo Canyon Lands Conservation Framework

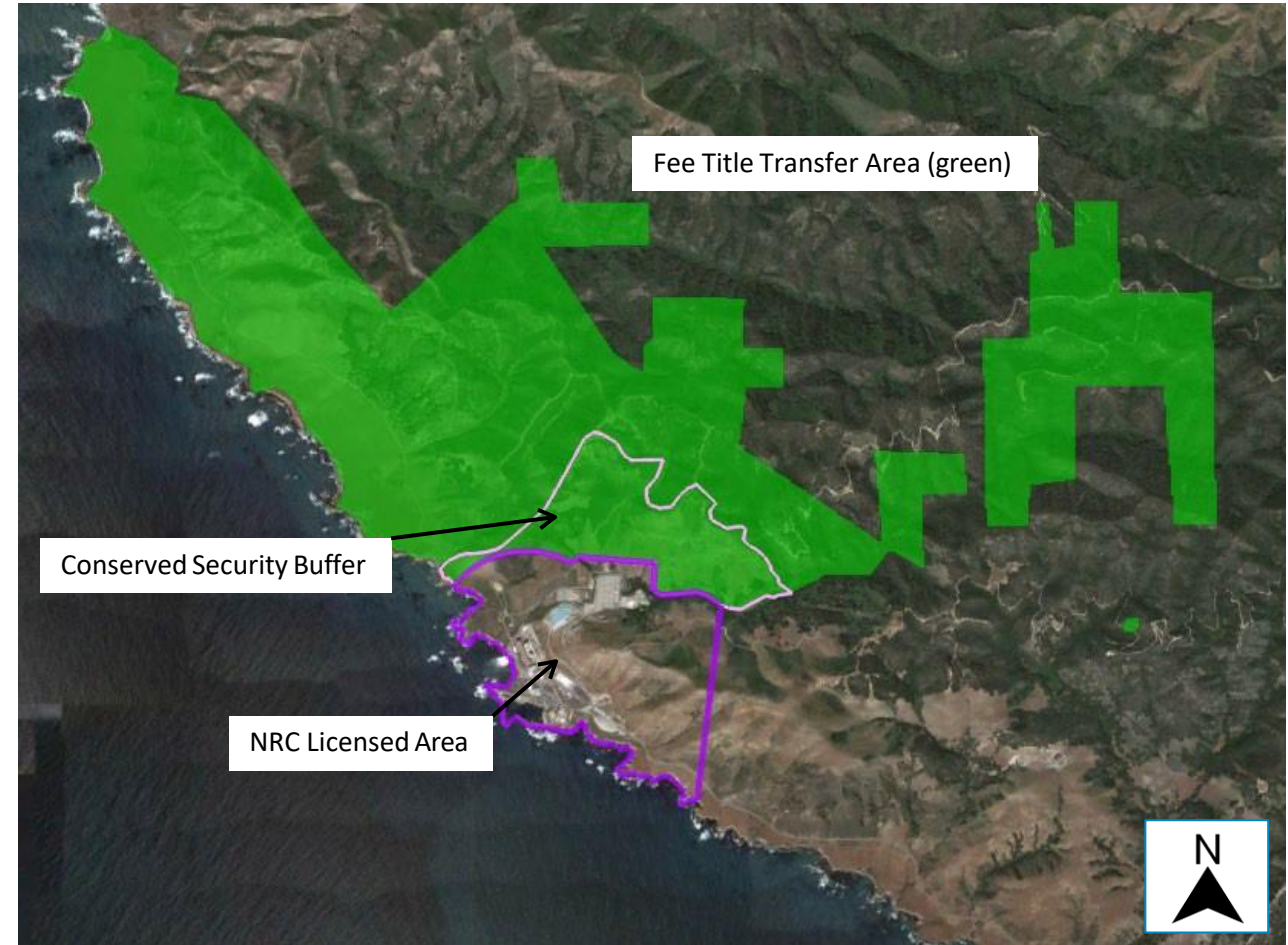


North Ranch Dedication and Conservation Easement

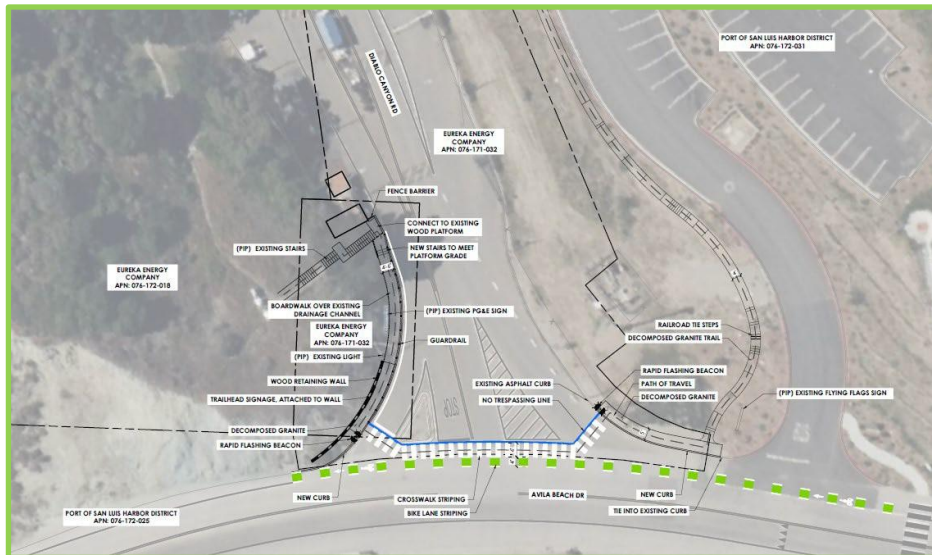

1. Docent ratio set to 20:1

3. De-coupled Pecho and Pt. Buchon maximum hiker limit
4. Website & registration improvements
5. Revised Operational Agreement with Coastal staff
6. Walk-up registration now allowed if tour scheduled
7. New entrance design
