Office of Emergency Services (OES)

Nuclear Power Preparedness (NPP)

- **Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC)** regulates US powerplants
- **Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)** oversees and ensures County OES is planning and prepared should an emergency arise
- **State Office of Emergency Management (CA OES)** ensures that the County OES has the financial resources to plan and be prepared
- **County OES** serves as the coordinating agency for off-site emergency response for nuclear emergencies for the Diablo Canyon Power Plant.



Planning and Preparedness Activities

- Maintain and implement the NPP Emergency Response Plan and 59 comprehensive Standard Operating Procedures
- Coordinate, train and exercise with over 40 agencies/entities
- Conduct evaluated exercises with all agencies/entities
- Maintain radiological response equipment & facilities
- Provide public education within a 50 miles of Diablo Canyon



Planning and Preparedness Activities

Conduct drills, full-scale exercise evaluations, and ensure regulatory compliance as directed by the NRC & FEMA

Exercise	Frequency
DCPP Emergency Operations	Every 3 Months
Plume Exposure	Every 2 Years
Hostile Action	Every 8 Years
Ingestion Pathway	Every 8 Years
Monitoring and Decontamination	3 per 8 Years
Medical Services	Every Year
Alert & Notification System	Every Year
