



MAINTENANCE NOTICE

Arroyo Grande Creek Channel Hazard Tree and Debris Removal

The San Luis Obispo Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will be removing tree failures identified as flood risks within the channel. The project area is outlined in red below.

WHAT

District staff has identified and will remove multiple hazardous trees (trees with broken tops or major damage to the structural branches) in preparation for the upcoming storm season.

During storm events, hazardous trees propose a threat of increased flood risk and structural damage to the levee. The trees identified for removal pose the greatest potential threat to the levee. Work will be conducted by an experienced tree crew with full compliance monitoring support.

YOUR SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY.

Never enter a flood control channel, as they can be dangerous and public access is restricted. Please stay out of the project area and observe all project safety signs, barriers, and personnel.

District staff will continue to provide updates on upcoming storm preparation activities.
