

MAINTENANCE NOTICE

Arroyo Grande Creek Channel Weed Abatement by Goat Grazing

The San Luis Obispo Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will be utilizing goats to graze portions of the Arroyo Grande Creek Channel. The grazing activity will be marked off with signage and cones.

WHAT

District staff will be providing weed abatement and vegetation management services utilizing grazing animals within the downstream portion of Arroyo Grande Creek. Grazing the channel areas is an effective, ecologically sensitive method of weed abatement for the sensitive creek habitat.

We understand there are regulations for growing and selling produce, including prohibition of grazing animals within specified notices. We are providing this notice to the surrounding community to plan accordingly and consider appropriate crop plantings and harvest times that will not be impacted by grazing activities. District staff has already reached out to the parties that would be most affected by these activities, and this announcement serves as additional notice for the local community.

YOUR SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY

Never enter a flood control channel, as they can be dangerous and public access is restricted. Please stay out of the project area and observe all project safety signs, barriers, and personnel.

Please minimize all disturbances to the grazing animals and project areas. No feeding or touching the goats.
