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# Ongoing Updates on IRWM Grants

## Prop 84 Implementation Grants

- 2011 Round 1
  - Nipomo CSD Supplemental Water Supply Phase 1 complete
  - Zone 1/1A – permitting/regulatory issues
  - Los Osos Wastewater Projects – all connections to be completed by December 2017



# Ongoing Updates on IRWM Grants

## Prop 84 Implementation Grants

- 2014 Drought - all projects complete
  - CSA 23 / AMWC / GF Emergency Intertie
  - Heritage Ranch Emergency Intertie
  - Cambria CSD Emergency Water Supply



# Ongoing Updates on IRWM Grants

## Prop 84 Implementation Grants

- 2015 “Last Round”
  - Templeton CSD Conjunctive Use – in progress
  - San Simeon CSD Wellhead Treatment - complete
  - Oceano CSD Water Resource Reliability Program Feasibility Studies – in progress



# Ongoing Updates on IRWM Grants

## Prop 1 Planning Grant

- Plan Update – planning in progress
  - RWMG Workshop - **June 7 ,2017**
- Stormwater Resource Plan
  - SWRCB and DWR in alignment to combine efforts on a region-wide plan



# Ongoing Updates on IRWM Grants

## Disadvantaged Community Involvement

- Approved by BOS on March 21
- Submitting proposal to DWR **in April**
- SLO County Needs Assessment
  - Upon DWR approval, will go out for RFP





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# Full Project List

- Status update needed on 168 existing projects/concepts
- Including solicitations Prop 84 Drought and Prop 84 2015 Implementation grant round



# Project Solicitation Process

## Phase 1a – Gathering abstracts by May 12

- RWMG Working Group to pass/fail abstracts by June 7 RWMG meeting (no meeting on May 3)

# Project Solicitation Process

## Condition #1 – IRWM related?

- Is it regional?
- Multiple agencies?
- Multiple benefits?
- Supports critical water supply or water quality need within a DAC boundary?

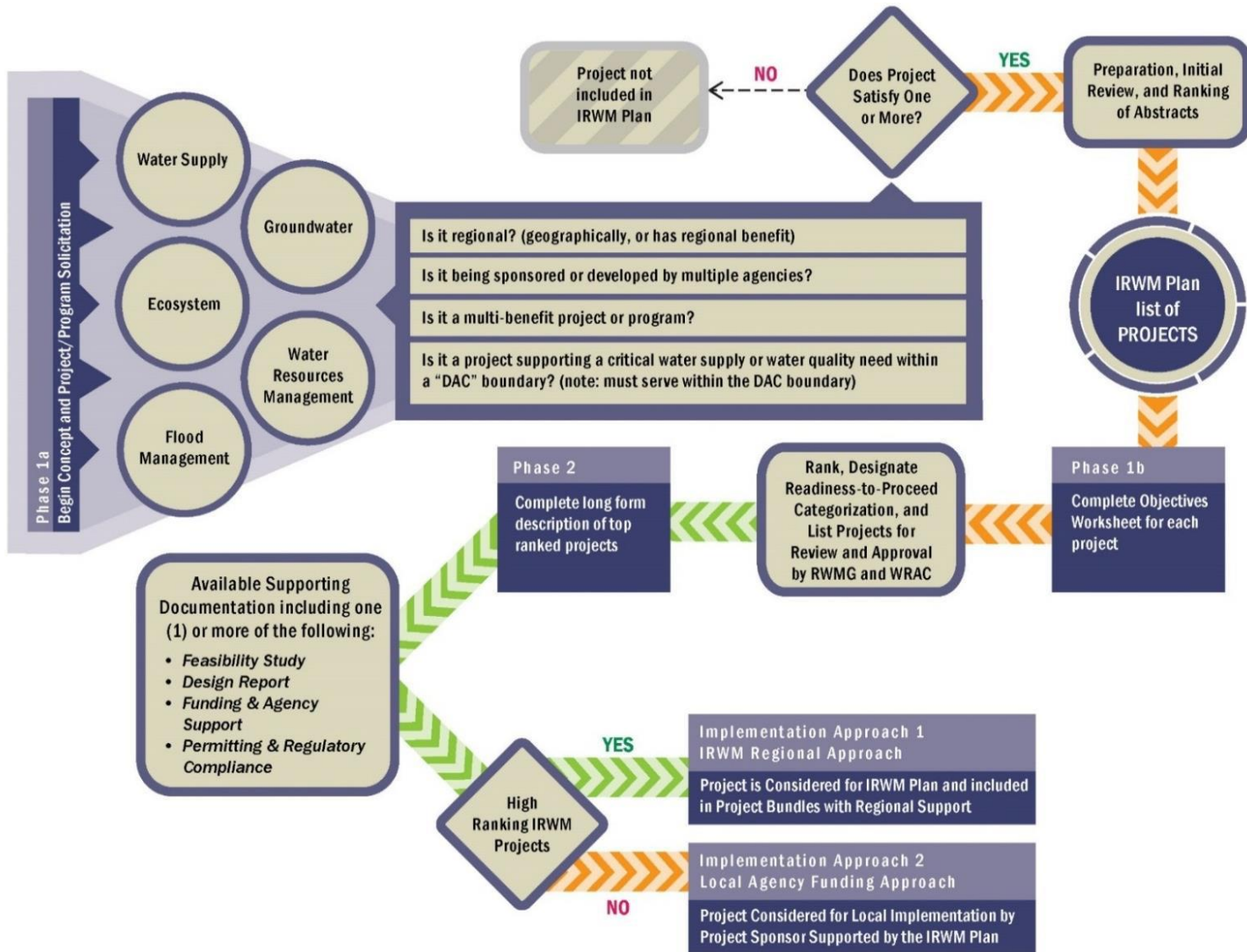


# Project Solicitation Process

Condition #2 – Meets one or more IRWM Goals and satisfies multiple objectives?

- Water Supply
- Ecosystem and Watershed
- Groundwater Monitoring & Management
- Flood Management
- Water Resources Management & Communications





# Project Solicitation Process

**Phase 1b** – RWMG Working Group contacts project sponsors on **passed** projects

- Project Objectives Worksheet requested and used to Score and Rank
- Readiness-to-Proceed (RTP) scoring
- Results in updated Full Project List for RWMG and WRAC approval



# Project Solicitation Process

## Phase 2 – Long Form

Requested from projects satisfying the multiple criteria for suitability as an IRWM project for the purposes of plan implementation

Results in Short Project List

- DAC projects (min. expenditure)
- Project/program integration
- Opportunities/challenges based on prior grant rounds
