I. CALL TO ORDER

A. Roll Call for Quorum Count

A Commission meeting was held on Thursday, August 28, 2025, at 4:00 P.M., with Commissioner Francis (Vice Chair) serving as the Chair. Quorum established at 100% (minimum of 3/5 seats present with voting share > 51%).

B. Flag Salute

Everyone stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. REVIEW OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

A. Meeting minutes for May 22, 2025, were recommended for approval. No questions from the board, and no further discussion by the Commission.

Motion for approval: Peschong; Seconded: Petersen; Passed.

IV. COMMISSION INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

A. NWP Operations Update with Reservoir Status

AMcKenna provided update of the reservoir and temporary pipeline, Flood Hazard Mitigation. The reservoir is at 43%, with the temporary pipeline—operational since July 7—paused due to the Gifford Fire. Only Paso Robles is currently using NWP water, and staff are evaluating a temporary repair site for possible yelomine reinstallation. A \$370,000 Flood Hazard Mitigation Study, funded mostly by FEMA, was awarded to GHD to assess risks and propose mitigation alternatives. This is the first step in addressing six NWP breaks, with one project expected to emerge from the analysis. Third Quarter Operations Budget Report – FY 2024-25 Harold W. Public Works Finance: Similar to past few years. At 57% for maintenance \$1,600,000 left. Will be credited if not spent by end of year. Non-routine 20% spent approximately \$11,000,000 of budget left.

Rory Powell: Line Item 6 is this project related to the project Peschong is asking about.

Harold W.: Responded that the project Peschong is talking about is Line before 23 STORM NACI PIPELINE REPAIRS.

V. COMMISSION ACTION ITEMS

- B. Staff recommends reallocating a total of \$474,598 in existing budget savings to cover the remaining costs for the Yerba Buena project. This amount includes \$250,769 in savings from the completed El Camino Bridge over Santa Margarita Creek pipe relocation project, \$200,000 in unused anticipated capital project funds, and \$23,829 from the General Units budget line item.

Staff Recommendation: Approve Fund Reallocation

Motion for approval: Hamon; Seconded; Neil; Roll Call Vote. Passed Unanimously.

Figures summarizing the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Second Quarterly Operating Fund Budget are provided for your information. With 50% of the year elapsed, total expenditures and purchase order commitments are at 13.7% of budget. This includes Non-Routine projects that fluctuate during the fiscal year. More notably, annual Routine Operations and Maintenance efforts are at less than budgeted levels at 28.1% of the budget.

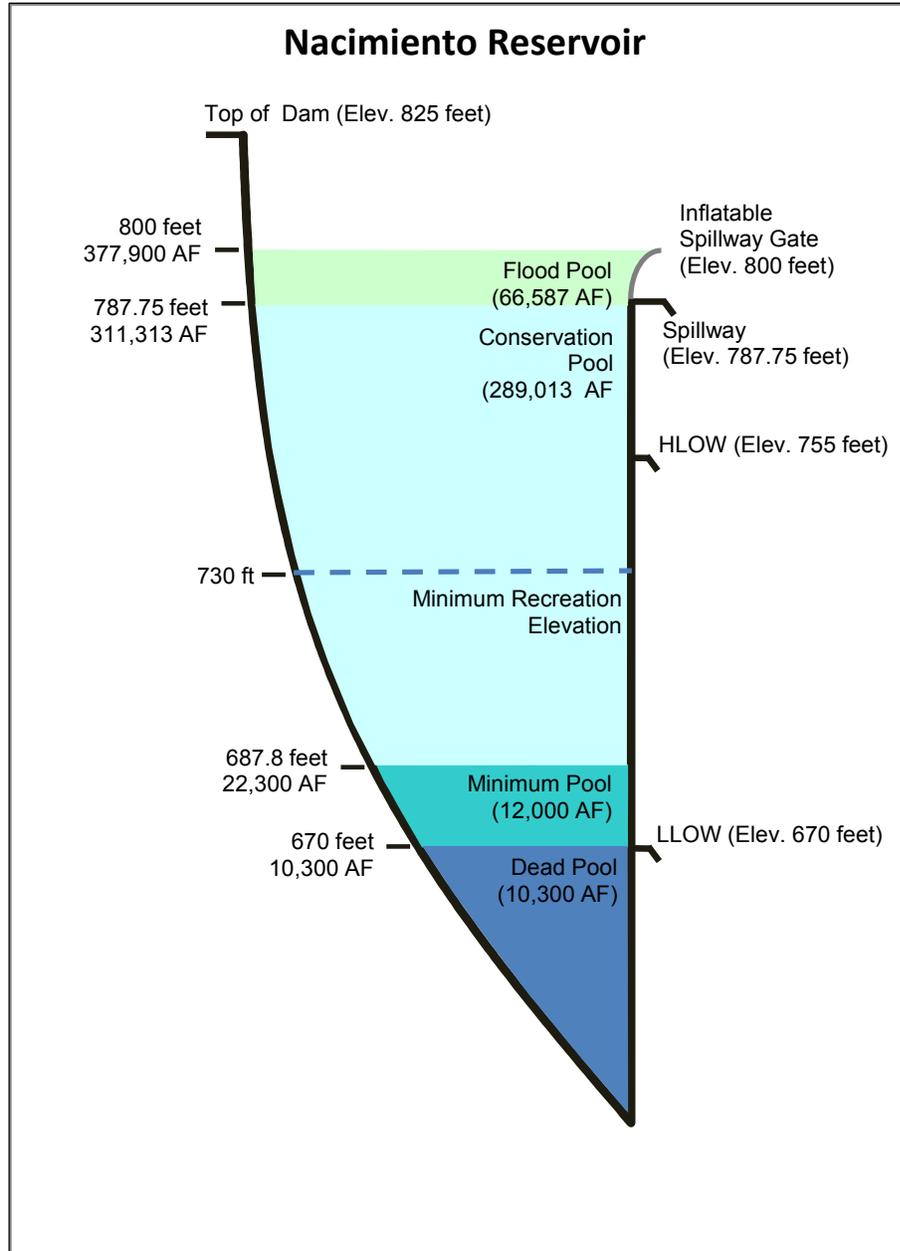


Figure 1. Schematic of Nacimiento Reservoir Pools
