

Delta Conveyance Project Overview (SWP)




- Protects Delivery Reliability
 - Bethany Reservoir Alignment
 - Two points of diversion (NOD)
 - 45-mile tunnel
 - 6,000 cfs capacity
 - Adds export location (SOD)
 - Mitigates seismic risk
 - Geographic diversity of supply
 - Increased allocations to District
 - Est. \$255/AFY ("2020 dollars")
 - Incl. planning & design costs

What is the Goal of the Delta Conveyance Project (DCP)?

- Protect the ability to deliver water to California (including SLO County)
 - Potential <u>average 10-17% allocation reduction</u> without DCP (2,500-4200 AF).
- SLO County FC&WCD goal is to **maximize SWP** water supply for the <u>reliability</u> and <u>resiliency</u> benefits to SLO County.
- The DCP is a concrete step towards these goals.

What is the County Commitment?

- Funding in 2020 and 2022 for preliminary planning, design, environmental review and permitting.
- DWR completed the EIR (Dec 2023), updated cost estimate (2024).
- Funding needed to continue planning and "pre-construction work" in 2026-27 to complete project permitting and design.
- Revenues from the 2024 water transfer are available to offset these costs for the District.


What is the County Commitment?

The District's cost share for 2026-27 is \$1.86 million.

Limited findings (under CEQA) are required to address the pre-construction work.

 The District is <u>not yet being asked to approve or commit</u> to the broader DCP.
