What is this?

Encroachment (ENC) Applications to be submitted electronically through Citizens Connect Online Portal

Starting in early June of 2025, Public Works Development Services will no longer accept PDF application submittals via email.

All Encroachment (ENC) Permit applications, including Special Events, will need to be submitted online through "Citizens Connect Online Application & Payment Portal" This is the same portal where online payments are currently made. With this new process, all applicable/ supporting documentation will need to be uploaded prior to submitting the online application. Please note all correspondence will still be via email once the initial application is submitted electronically via the Citizens Connect Online Application Portal and received by Public Works.
