Board Approved Storm Response Strategy:

- Created a focused team
- Strategically address repairs within FEMA guidelines
- Provided internal County loans = maximize reimbursement from FEMA
- Completed work to date
 All of 385 debris removal sites

 - All of 238 emergency openings166 of 256 permanent repair sites remain

FEMA Guidelines for Recovery Projects

- "Emergency Opening" vs "Permanent Repair"
- "In-Kind" vs "Betterment"
- Staffing / Project Approval

Cecchetti Rd Creek Crossing FEMA Betterment Project




Challenges:

- Secondary access = not a FEMA Emergency
- Identified fish barrier = complicated permits
- FEMA Betterment = longer FEMA process
- 100-year flood plain
- Lopez Lake full
- AG Creek Watershed

The Good News

- FEMA is engaged
- Applied for CA Fish and Wildlife grant for Planning, Design and Permitting
- Anticipated 2026 construction

Project Delivery Process

NOW:

- Establishing a conceptual design
- Work towards 65% design
- Coordinating with FEMA and regulatory agencies on "concurrence"

NEXT YEAR:

- Complete design
- Obtain permits

2026:

- Bidding (Estimated cost = \$2.4 \$4 million)
- Construction

Huasna Rd Bridge Replacement Project Overview



Huasna Rd Bridge Replacement Project Overview

Federal Funded bridge replacement project

- Planned since 2018
- Current bridge is deficient and beyond planned useful life

Construction Timing

- 2027 (planned)
- May November

Huasna Rd Bridge Replacement Project Overview

Construction Detour Necessary

- Partial bridge closure (one lane) or temp bridge not viable
- Detour on Cecchetti Road & Branch Mill Road
- Maximum 3 miles for residents adjacent to bridge

Environmental Review Almost Complete

- 30 Day public review period begins July 2024
