

**LOS OSOS WASTEWATER SYSTEM
CONNECTION/CAPACITY CHARGES

Los Osos Wastewater System Connection/Capacity Charge - The purposes of the sewer connection/capacity charge are (a) to provide revenue to acquire, construct, install and replace capital facilities and other assets required for the Los Osos wastewater disposal system, and (b) to distribute the cost of acquisition, construction, installation, and replacement of the wastewater facilities and other capital assets so that the owner of each parcel connected to the system pays a proportionate share of those costs.

2. The beginning and ending balance of the fund and the interest earned from investment of moneys in the fund.
3. The amount of charges collected in that fiscal year.
