2022 Data of scams towards seniors (obtained from FBI)

- 88,000 complaints received from scams targeted to individuals age 60 and older
- Over 3 billion dollars in financial loss
- Compared to previous year 2021 there was a 82.35% increase
- Raised increase in the sophisticated way scams are being developed
- Seniors are seen as a population with a higher income due to retirements, life-time savings, 401K etc...

Prevention Methods

- Education empowerment
- Presentations to providers, family members etc...

Recent and Local Scams

- Pop-ups in computer of seniors, stating the computer has been compromised with confidential information asked to call a certain #
- Seniors called a scammer without realizing it and banking information was compromised
- Senior was told they would be sent an individual to their home
- Scammers went over to seniors' houses and used "code words"
- Biggest loss was of an individual handing over money \$120,000
- "Pig butchering scam" fattening up the scams
 - > Building up a relationship between and scammer and senior

- Offer to help invest your \$
- Create fake sites to trick individuals into investing and thinking they are increasing their money

- Government impersonation scam
- Sweepstakes
- Phone scam
- Computer tech scam
- Grandparent scam
- Romance scam
- Charity/donations imposter scam
- Investment scam
- Health insurance scam
- Daily internet and email frauds
