1. Call to Order and Introductions

Lawren (on behalf of Jack) called the meeting to order at 11:03 am.

2. Public Comment

Linda shared that the Homeless Services Division went to the SLO County Board of Supervisors meeting yesterday to request permission to apply for the Older Adults Guaranteed Income Pilot Program. This is a grant application to the California Department of Social Services in total amount up to \$4,750,000. This grant, which is aimed at 60 years old and above, is to last 36 months total for the duration of the program. She also mentioned that this fund will probably provide a minimum of 200 individuals guaranteed income

between \$750-\$1000 each month, with no requirements for any case management. Since the Board of Supervisors granted the request, Linda also welcomes any letters of support from different service providers to include in the application form.

In reference to the HSOC priority setting meeting held last Wednesday, Janna expressed her concern about how the prioritization process is going to work if funding is cut and providers are faced with the challenges of looking for other funding resources.

Susan mentioned that Lumina Alliance is applying for a grant to assist them with the technical undertaking of CalAIM. She is inviting collaboration with other agencies to get some assistance in this task.

Jack introduced Howard Padua from UCLA and an evaluator for the CAPSLO SLO Hub grant.

Liz from People's Self Help Housing shared that the Calle Joaquin housing project is looking to be ready for occupancy in July and will start to get referrals in April.

Janna moved the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Linda. Minutes were approved by voice vote.







Household Information - Latest Coordinated Entry Enrollment






