AMERICAN RED CROSS TO PROVIDE CLEANUP KITS TO RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY STORMS

San Luis Obispo, CA – The American Red Cross in coordination with the County of San Luis Obispo is providing cleanup kits to residents who have experienced damage to their home or property due to the storms.

The kits include buckets, shovels, disinfectants, brooms, sponges, gloves, masks, and other items that can be used to remove water, mud, or debris. They are also providing comfort kits with personal hygiene items and water and snacks to those who need them.

The kits are being distributed at the following locations on Sunday, January 15th:

- **Oceano:** Oceano Depot, 1650 Front St from 10-11 am
- **Los Osos:** Vista Court neighborhood from 1-2 pm
- **Templeton:** Templeton Fire Station, 206 5th St from 3-4 pm

“We are proud of our partnership with the American Red Cross,” said Anita Konopa, the County Emergency Operations Center Care and Shelter Branch Director, “they are always here for the community in times of need.”
