EVACUATION WARNING LIFTED FOR RESIDENTS IN LOS OSOS

San Luis Obispo, CA – San Luis Obispo County has lifted the Evacuation Warning for residents in Los Osos.

Residents in the Montana Way neighborhoods, El Dorado St, and Marianela Ln in Los Osos were issued an Evacuation Warning on Saturday, January 14 due to flooding. Because the threat of heavy rain has passed, the Evacuation Warning has been lifted.

The Evacuation Order and Evacuation Warning for residents in Oceano near the Arroyo Grande Creek Levee/Oceano Lagoon remains in place.
