19 Plaintiff, THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, appearing through its  
20 attorneys, Dan Dow, District Attorney of San Luis Obispo County and Kenneth J. Jorgensen  
21 Deputy District Attorney, and Defendants BLACK PEARL SPORTFISHING LLC. and BRIAN  
22 RAYMOND WALKER (“Defendants”), appearing through their attorney, John William  
23 Galardi (SBN: 199087), having stipulated to the entry of this Final Civil Judgment Pursuant to  
24 Stipulation (“Final Judgment”) without the Court taking evidence, and the Court having  
25 considered the pleadings and good cause appearing:

26 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Plaintiff has judgment  
27 against Defendants as follows:  
28

1 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

2 1. This action is brought under the laws of the State of California, and this Court  
3 has jurisdiction of the subject matter hereof and the parties hereto.

4 **APPLICABILITY**

5 2. All provisions of this Judgment apply to Defendants BLACK PEARL  
6 SPORTFISHING LLC. (the owner of a commercial passenger fishing vessel, the “Black Pearl”  
7 [Fish and Game number 37797]), any operator of the “Black Pearl” while owned by BLACK  
8 PEARL SPORTFISHING LLC., employees of BLACK PEARL SPORTFISHING LLC., and  
9 BRIAN RAYMOND WALKER (“Enjoined Parties”).

10 **INJUNCTION**

11 3. Defendants shall be and are now permanently enjoined and restrained under  
12 Business and Professions Code section 17203 from fishing in any closed area located off the  
13 shores of California.

14 4. Defendants shall be enjoined and restrained under Business and Professions  
15 Code section 17203 for five years from violating California Code of Regulations, Title 14,  
16 Section 190(a). Specifically, Defendants will not enter caught fish as “unspecified rockfish”  
17 when the electronic log provides for a specific subcategory of rockfish species.

18 5. Defendants shall be enjoined and restrained under Business and Professions  
19 Code section 17203 for five years from violating California Code of Regulations, Title 14,  
20 Section 28.55(b), which limits the daily fish catch per person within the Rockfish, Cabezon, and  
21 Greenling complex.

22 **MONETARY RELIEF**

23 6. Defendants shall, pursuant to California Unlawful Competition Law under  
24 Business and Professions Code section 17206, pay Plaintiff the total of \$10,600.00 in civil  
25 penalties within 30 days.

26 7. Defendants shall, pursuant to California Unlawful Competition Law under  
27 Business and Professions Code section 17206, pay the total of \$2,000.00 to the San Luis Obispo  
28

1 County Fish and Game Fund, which funds are restricted to be spent on programs and projects  
2 demonstrating a benefit to the fish and wildlife of San Luis Obispo County and in compliance  
3 with Section 13103 of the Fish and Game Code.

4 8. The payments shall be by check, cashier's check, money order, or certified  
5 check. The payments shall be made payable to the "Treasurer of the County of San Luis  
6 Obispo." Payment(s) shall be delivered to Kenneth Jorgensen, Deputy District Attorney,  
7 Consumer and Environmental Protection Unit, San Luis Obispo County District Attorney's  
8 Office, 1035 Palm Street, Room 450, San Luis Obispo, CA 93408, San Luis Obispo, California,  
9 93408. Upon full payment of the sum of \$12,600.00, all monetary obligations are deemed  
10 satisfied in full.

11 9. All notices, reports, and correspondence required by or in conjunction with this

28 **RETENTION OF JURISDICTION**

10. Jurisdiction shall be retained by the Court for the purpose of enabling any party  
to this Final Judgment to apply to the Court at any time for such further orders, directions,  
modifications, or terminations as may be necessary or appropriate for the construction, carrying

1 out, modification or termination of any of the injunctive provisions of this Final Judgment, and  
2 the enforcement of compliance herewith; or for the punishment of violations hereunder.

3 **EFFECT OF FINAL JUDGMENT**

4 11. Nothing in this Final Judgment shall be construed as limiting, altering, or  
5 otherwise affecting the rights, procedures, and protections afforded to Defendant under  
6 California Fish and Game Code, nor shall a minor violation that is cured be considered a  
7 violation of this Final Judgment.

8 **INTEGRATION**

9 12. This Final Judgment constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties hereto  
10 and may not be amended or supplemented except as provided herein.

11 **MODIFICATION**

12 13. This Final Judgment may be modified upon written consent by all Parties and the  
13 approval of the Court.

14 14. The clerk is ordered to enter this Judgment immediately, and to provide notice to
