The District Attorney of San Luis Obispo County, California, hereby accuses the
above named defendants of the following criminal offenses:

Count 1

On or about October 6, 2024, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the crime of Assault By Means Likely To Produce Great Bodily Injury in violation of PC245(a)(4), a Felony, was committed in that ALEX BRANDON LOPEZRAMIREZ AND MIGUEL ANGEL MENDEZ AND BRIAN RAMIREZLOPEZ did willfully and unlawfully commit an assault on [REDACTED] by means of force likely to produce great bodily injury.

Enhancement

PC12022.7(a): Special Allegation - Great Bodily Injury

It is further alleged as to Count 1 that in the commission of the above offense the said defendants, ALEX BRANDON LOPEZRAMIREZ AND BRIAN RAMIREZLOPEZ AND MIGUEL ANGEL MENDEZ, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7(a) and also causing the above offense to become a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8).

NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8)

Enhancement

PC186.22(b)(1)(C): Special Allegation - Street Terrorism - Violent Felony

It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code section 186.22(b)(1)(C) as to Count 1 that the above offense was committed by the said defendants, ALEX BRANDON LOPEZRAMIREZ AND BRIAN RAMIREZLOPEZ AND MIGUEL ANGEL MENDEZ, for the benefit of, at the direction of, or in association with a criminal street gang, to wit: West Park, with the specific intent to promote, further or assist in criminal conduct by gang members. Said act also caused the above offense to become a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code section 1192.7(c)(28).

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code section 186.30(a). Willful failure to register is a crime.

Count 2

On or about October 6, 2024, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the crime of Street Terrorism in violation of PC186.22(a), a Felony, was committed in that ALEX BRANDON LOPEZRAMIREZ AND MIGUEL ANGEL MENDEZ AND BRIAN RAMIREZLOPEZ did unlawfully and actively participate in a criminal street gang with knowledge that its members engage in and have engaged in a pattern of criminal gang activity and did promote, further and assist in felony criminal conduct by gang members.

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code section 186.30(a). Willful failure to register is a crime.

1 It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code Section 1170(b)(2) that one or more of the
2 following factors in aggravation listed in California Rule of Court 4.421 may apply to the
3 defendant(s) or to conduct of the defendant(s):

4 4.421(a)(1) The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily
5 harm, and other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness and callousness.

6 4.421(a)(2) The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the commission
7 of the crime.

8 4.421(a)(3) The victim was particularly vulnerable.

9 4.421(a)(4) The defendant induced others to participate in the commission of the crime and
10 occupied a position of leadership and dominance of other participants in its commission.

11 4.421(a)(5) The defendant induced a minor to commit or assist in the commission of the
12 crime.

13 4.421(a)(6) The defendant threatened witnesses, unlawfully prevented and dissuaded
14 witnesses from testifying, suborned perjury, and in any other way illegally interfered with
15 the judicial process.

16 4.421(a)(7) The defendant is charged with other crimes for which consecutive sentences
17 can be imposed but for which concurrent sentences shall be imposed.

18 4.421(a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning,
19 sophistication, or professionalism.

20 4.421(a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary
21 value.

22 4.421(a)(10) The crime involved a large quantity of contraband.

23 4.421(a)(11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust and confidence to commit
24 the offense.

25 4.421(a)(12) The crime constitutes a hate crime under section 422.55 of the Penal Code
26 and no hate crime enhancements under section 422.75 of the Penal Code shall be
27

1 imposed and the crime is not subject to sentencing under section 1170.8 of the Penal
2 Code.

3 4.421(b)(1) The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger
4 to society.

5 4.421(b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult and sustained petitions in juvenile
6 delinquency proceedings are numerous and of increasing seriousness.

7 4.421(b)(3) The defendant has served a prior term in prison and county jail under section
8 1170(h).

9 4.421(b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post release
10 community supervision, and parole when the crime was committed.

11 4.421(b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, post
12 release community supervision, and parole was unsatisfactory.

1 All of which is contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided, and against
2 the peace and dignity of the People of the State of California.

3 I declare that an investigation has been conducted to determine if said Defendant(s)
4 did commit the stated crime, which reports are attached hereto and incorporated herein by
5 reference, and that the facts therein show probable cause that the said Defendant(s) did
6 commit the crime. Your declarant requests the issuance of a Warrant of Arrest either if said
7 Defendant(s) do not appear voluntarily in response to an appearance letter, or if no
8 appearance letter was issued.

9 **Discovery Request:** Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1054.5(b), the People are
10 hereby informally requesting that defense counsel provide discovery to the people as
11 required by Penal Code Section 1054.3.
