- Counseling
- Court Support

What you can do

- Report tips or suspicious activity to your local law enforcement agency or call 911.
- Do not attempt to contact the suspected trafficker or try to rescue suspected victims.
- Educate yourselves and your colleagues about human trafficking and spread awareness.
- Be observant to your surroundings and social media
