20 The District Attorney of San Luis Obispo County, California, hereby accuses the
21 above named defendant of the following criminal offenses:

22 Count 1

23 On or about December 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
24 crime of Driving Under The Influence Of Any Drug Causing Injury in violation of
25 VC23153(f), a Felony, was committed in that RYAN JAMES JOHNSON did unlawfully,
26 while under the influence of a drug, drive a vehicle and in so driving, concurrently did an

act forbidden by law or neglected a duty imposed by law which proximately caused bodily injury to Pamela Ann Mays.

Enhancement

PC12022.7(c): Spec Alleg- Gbi - Elderly Victim

It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code section 12022.7(c) as to Count 1 that in the commission of the above offense the said defendant, RYAN JAMES JOHNSON, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Pamela Ann Mays, not an accomplice, who was 70 years of age or older.

NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8).

Count 2

On or about December 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the crime of Reckless Driving With Great Bodily Injury in violation of VC23104(b), a Felony, was committed in that RYAN JAMES JOHNSON did unlawfully drive a vehicle upon a highway in willful and wanton disregard for the safety of persons and property and did proximately cause great bodily injury, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7, to Pamela Ann Mays. It is further alleged that the defendant was previously convicted of a violation of Vehicle Code section 23152(b).

Enhancement

PC969f(a): Spec Alleg-Serious Felony; G.B.I. Allegation

It is further alleged that as to the offense listed in Count 2, RYAN JAMES JOHNSON personally inflicted great bodily injury on another person, other than an accomplice, within the meaning of Sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667 and 969f(a) of the Penal Code.

Count 3

On or about December 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the crime of Leaving The Scene Of An Accident in violation of VC20001(a), a Felony, was committed in that RYAN JAMES JOHNSON did unlawfully, and knowingly, being a driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to a person other than himself, fail

1 refuse, or neglect to give to the injured person or to a traffic or police officer at the scene of
2 the accident his name and address, the registration number of his vehicle, or the name of
3 the owner of said vehicle; to exhibit his operator's license; to render reasonable assistance
4 to the injured person; or perform the duties specified in Vehicle Code Sections 20003 and
5 20004.

6 Count 4

7 On or about December 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
8 crime of Hit-Run Driving in violation of VC20002(a), a Misdemeanor, was committed in that
9 RYAN JAMES JOHNSON was the driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in
10 damage to property, who did unlawfully fail to stop the vehicle at the scene of the accident
11 and comply with subsection(s) (1) and/or (2) of Vehicle Code section 20002(a).

12 Count 5

13 On or about December 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
14 crime of Driving When Privilege Suspended For Prior DUI Conviction in violation of
15 VC14601.2(a), a Misdemeanor, was committed in that RYAN JAMES JOHNSON did
16 unlawfully drive a motor vehicle upon a highway at a time when his driving privilege was
17 suspended or revoked for driving under the influence of an alcoholic beverage, a drug, or
18 their combined influence, and when he had knowledge of said suspension or revocation.

19 Count 6

20 On or about December 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
21 crime of Escape From Arrest in violation of PC836.6(b), a Misdemeanor, was committed in
22 that RYAN JAMES JOHNSON did unlawfully attempt to or did escape from a peace officer
23 after being lawfully arrested. The defendant was, at the time, under arrest and knew or
24 should have known, by the exercise of reasonable care, that he was under arrest.

 26 defendant(s) or to conduct of the defendant(s):

 28

1 4.421(a)(1) The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily
2 harm, and other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness and callousness.

3 4.421(a)(2) The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the
4 commission of the crime.

5 4.421(a)(3) The victim was particularly vulnerable.

6 4.421(a)(4) The defendant induced others to participate in the commission of the crime
7 and occupied a position of leadership and dominance of other participants in its
8 commission.

9 4.421(a)(5) The defendant induced a minor to commit and assist in the commission of the
10 crime.

11 4.421(a)(6) The defendant threatened witnesses, unlawfully prevented and dissuaded
12 witnesses from testifying, suborned perjury, and in any other way illegally interfered with
13 the judicial process.

14 4.421(a)(7) The defendant is charged with other crimes for which consecutive sentences
15 can be imposed but for which concurrent sentences shall be imposed.

16 4.421(a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning,
17 sophistication, and professionalism.

18 4.421(a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary
19 value.

20 4.421(a)(10) The crime involved a large quantity of contraband.

21 4.421(a)(11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust and confidence to commit
22 the offense.

23 4.421(a)(12) The crime constitutes a hate crime under section 422.55 of the Penal Code
24 and no hate crime enhancements under section 422.75 of the Penal Code shall be
25 imposed and the crime is not subject to sentencing under section 1170.8 of the Penal
26 Code.

27 4.421(b)(1) The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger
28 to society.


1 4.421(b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult and sustained petitions in
2 juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous and of increasing seriousness.
3 4.421(b)(3) The defendant has served a prior term in prison and county jail under section
4 1170(h).
5 4.421(b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post release
6 community supervision, and parole when the crime was committed.
7 4.421(b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, post
8 release community supervision, and parole was unsatisfactory.
