The District Attorney of San Luis Obispo County, California, hereby accuses the
above named defendant of the following criminal offenses:

Count 1

On or about June 10, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
crime of Discharge Of Firearm With Gross Negligence in violation of PC246.3(a), a Felony,
was committed in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did willfully and unlawfully
discharge a firearm in a grossly negligent manner which could result in injury and death to
a person.

1 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section
2 1192.7(c).

3 Enhancement

4 PC969F(A): Spec Alleg-Serious Felony; Weapon Allegation

5 It is further alleged that as to the offense listed in Count 1, CHARLES VINCENT
6 HOJABOOM personally used a dangerous and deadly weapon, to wit a shotgun, within the
7 meaning of Sections 1192.7(c) and 667 and 969F(A) of the Penal Code.

8 Count 2

9 On or about June 10, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
10 crime of Possession Of A Loaded Firearm On A College Or University in violation of
11 PC626.9(H), a Felony, was committed in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did
12 willfully and unlawfully bring and possess a loaded firearm upon the grounds of a campus
13 of, and buildings owned and operated for student housing, teaching, research and
14 administration by, a public and private university and college.

15 Count 3

16 On or about June 17, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
17 crime of Possession Of A Loaded Firearm On A College Or University in violation of
18 PC626.9(H), a Felony, was committed in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did
19 willfully and unlawfully bring and possess a loaded firearm upon the grounds of a campus
20 of, and buildings owned and operated for student housing, teaching, research and
21 administration by, a public and private university and college.

22 Count 4

23 On or about October 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
24 crime of Shooting At An Inhabited Dwelling in violation of PC246, a Felony, was committed
25 in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did willfully, unlawfully, and maliciously
26 discharge a firearm at an inhabited dwelling house, occupied building, inhabited housecar
27 and inhabited camper located at Cal Poly State University, San Luis Obispo.

1 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section
2 1192.7(c)(33).

3 NOTICE: Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1203.095, conviction of Penal Code Section
4 245(a)(2), Penal Code Section 245(d)(1), Penal Code Section 246 or Penal Code Section
5 417(c) mandates imprisonment for at least six months if probation is granted or the
6 execution or imposition of sentence is suspended.

7 Count 5

8 On or about October 27, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
9 crime of Possession Of A Loaded Firearm On A College Or University in violation of
10 PC626.9(H), a Felony, was committed in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did
11 willfully and unlawfully bring and possess a loaded firearm upon the grounds of a campus
12 of, and buildings owned and operated for student housing, teaching, research and
13 administration by, a public and private university and college.

14 Count 6

15 On or about November 11, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
16 crime of Possession Of A Loaded Firearm On A College Or University in violation of
17 PC626.9(H), a Felony, was committed in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did
18 willfully and unlawfully bring and possess a loaded firearm, to wit a pistol, upon the
19 grounds of a campus of, and buildings owned and operated for student housing, teaching,
20 research and administration by, a public and private university and college.

21 Count 7

22 On or about November 11, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
23 crime of Possession Of A Loaded Firearm On A College Or University in violation of
24 PC626.9(H), a Felony, was committed in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did
25 willfully and unlawfully bring and possess a loaded firearm, to wit a shotgun, upon the
26 grounds of a campus of, and buildings owned and operated for student housing, teaching,
27 research and administration by, a public and private university and college.

Count 8

On or about November 11, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the crime of Vandalism Less Than \$400.00 in violation of PC594(b)(2)(A), a Misdemeanor, was committed in that CHARLES VINCENT HOJABOOM did maliciously and unlawfully deface, damage and destroy real and personal property which belonged to another, in the amount of less than four hundred dollars (\$400.00).

It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code Section 1170(b)(2) that one or more of the following factors in aggravation listed in California Rule of Court 4.421 may apply to the defendant(s) or to conduct of the defendant(s):

4.421(a)(1) The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily harm, and other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness and callousness.

4.421(a)(2) The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the commission of the crime.

4.421(a)(3) The victim was particularly vulnerable.

4.421(a)(4) The defendant induced others to participate in the commission of the crime and occupied a position of leadership and dominance of other participants in its commission.

4.421(a)(5) The defendant induced a minor to commit and assist in the commission of the crime.

4.421(a)(6) The defendant threatened witnesses, unlawfully prevented and dissuaded witnesses from testifying, suborned perjury, and in any other way illegally interfered with the judicial process.

4.421(a)(7) The defendant is charged with other crimes for which consecutive sentences can be imposed but for which concurrent sentences shall be imposed.

4.421(a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, and professionalism.

1 4.421(a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary
2 value.

3 4.421(a)(10) The crime involved a large quantity of contraband.

4 4.421(a)(11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust and confidence to commit
5 the offense.

6 4.421(a)(12) The crime constitutes a hate crime under section 422.55 of the Penal Code
7 and no hate crime enhancements under section 422.75 of the Penal Code shall be
8 imposed and the crime is not subject to sentencing under section 1170.8 of the Penal
9 Code.

10 4.421(b)(1) The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger
11 to society.

12 4.421(b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult and sustained petitions in
13 juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous and of increasing seriousness.

14 4.421(b)(3) The defendant has served a prior term in prison and county jail under section
15 1170(h).

16 4.421(b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post release
17 community supervision, and parole when the crime was committed.

18 4.421(b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, post
19 release community supervision, and parole was unsatisfactory.

1 Contrary to the form, force and effect of that statute in such cases made and
2 provided and against the peace and dignity of the people of the State of California.
